Only type approved lamps appropriate for the size of the vessel may be fitted. IMO Resolution MSC.253(83) 'Performance Standards for Navigation Lights, Navigation Light Controllers and associated equipment' to be adhered to. The Administration ² will determine 'closest possible compliance' on a case-by-case basis whenever a vessel of special construction or purpose cannot fully comply with the provisions of any of these Standards.
