To: All shipowners, shipmanagers, designated persons of German ships

Sub.: 1. Guidelines for the operational implementation of the ISM Code by companies (MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.5)

- 2. Experience, qualifications and training for the role of designated person under the ISM Code (MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.6)
- 1. The Marine Environment Protection Committee (MEPC), at its fifty-sixth session, and the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC), at its eighty-third session, approved the guidelines for the operational implementation of the ISM Code by companies, issued as MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.5 and the guidelines on experience, qualifications and training for the role of designated person under the ISM Code, issued as MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.6.
- 2. Circular MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.5 contains guidelines for the operational implementation of the ISM Code by companies and establishes basic principles for:
- the role of the designated person under the ISM Code;
- reviewing safety management systems;
- reporting and analysing of non-conformities, accidents and near misses;
- performing internal safety audits and management reviews.
- 3. Circular MSC-MEPC.7/Circ.6 provides guidance to shipping companies on the experience, qualifications and training for the role of the designated person under the provisions of the ISM Code.
